**1968**

Established in 1968 as Navajo Community College, it was later renamed Diné College. The Navajo Nation sought to create an institution of higher education that encouraged Navajo youth to become contributing members of the Navajo Nation and the world

Rooted in Diné language and culture, our mission is to advance quality post-secondary student learning and development to ensure the well-being of the Diné People.




## Vision

## Articulation Task Force (ATF) Attendance




The last four academic years, faculty attendance was low due to several reasons:

# Increasing Faculty Engagement



## The Importance of Assessment Days




